Ricardo is survived by a host of family members and friends.

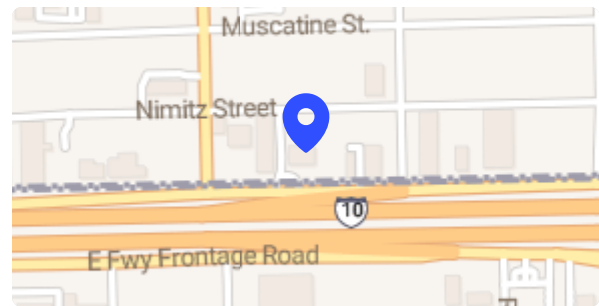

Ricardo will be missed by all who knew him and will remain in our hearts forever.






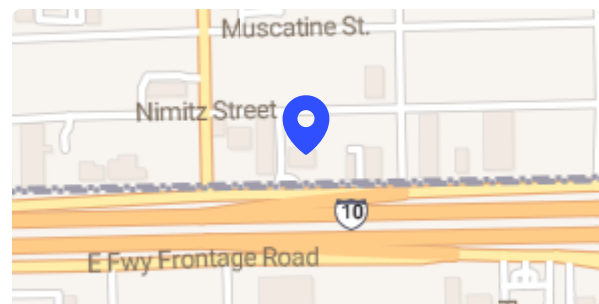
