The family would like to thank everyone for their thoughts and prayers during this difficult time.



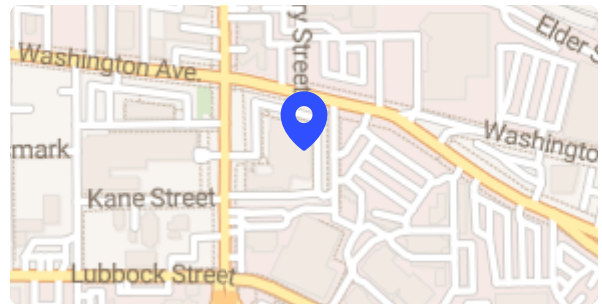
