The family would like to thank everyone for their thought and prayers during this time.



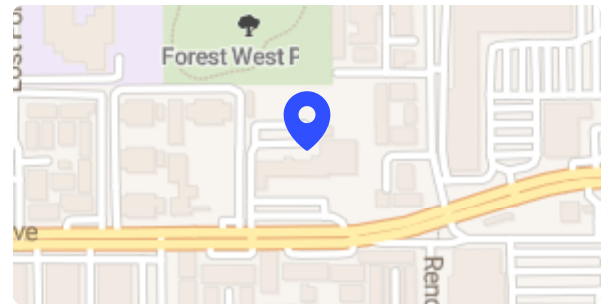

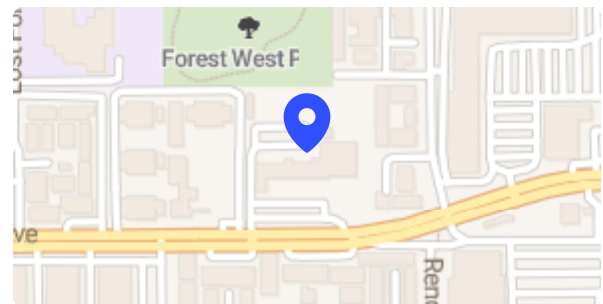

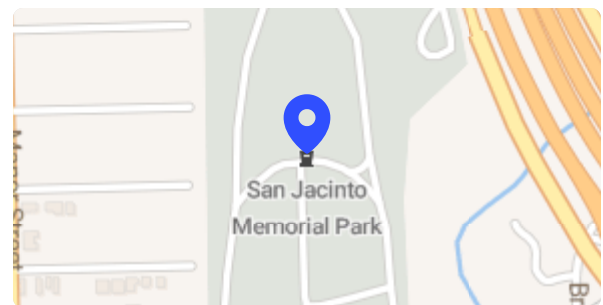
