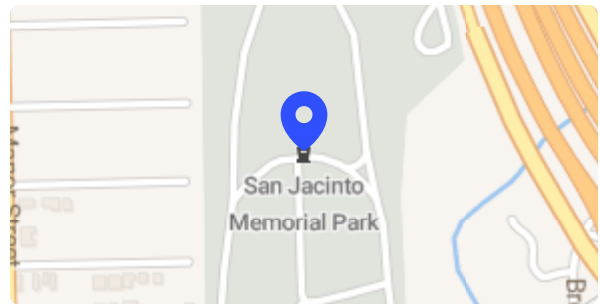

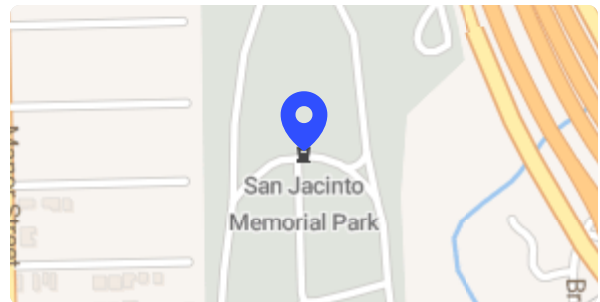

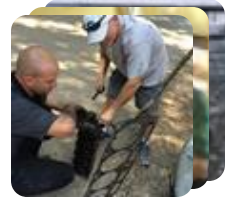

I love you Dad and miss you every single day. I miss our silly phone conversations and I'm sad that we didn't get that "one last time" to feed the squirrels at Herman Park.

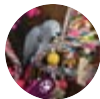

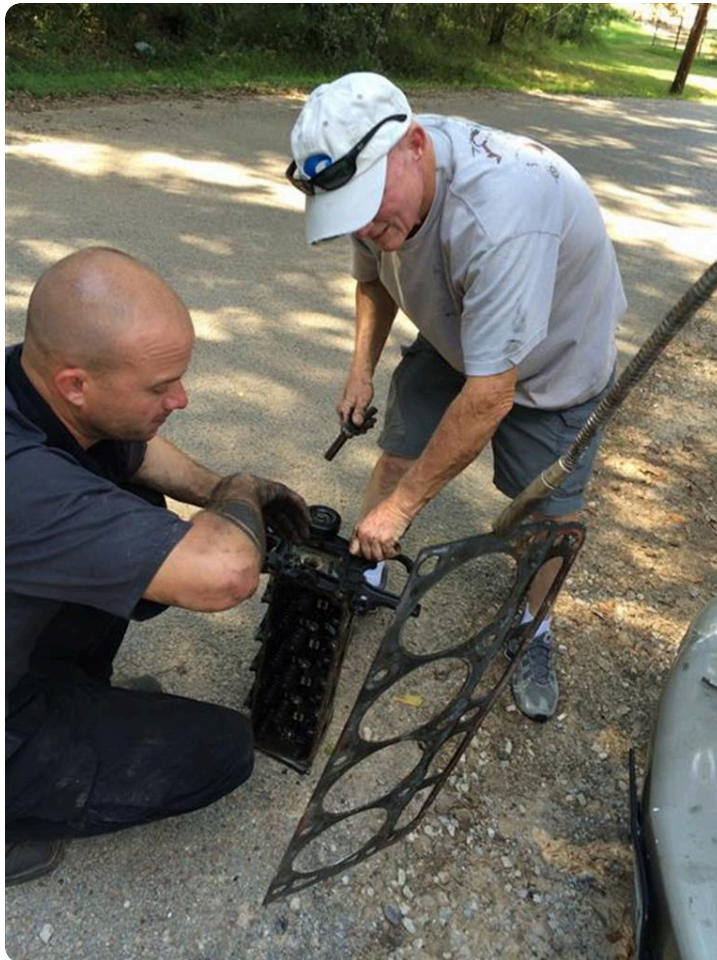
