**E**arline (Brown) Zelenevitz, age 85 yrs, entered into the kingdom of heaven on May 26, 2018 at her home, Arbor Terrace Retirement Center, Kingwood, Texas. While her family and friends mourn her passing, they also joyously celebrate a life long-lived.

Earline was born on July 25, 1932 in Oletha, TX, to Earl E. and Lola Pearl Bradshaw. She was the eldest daughter in a family of three girls and one boy. Earline served as secretary of Woodland Acres Elementary and Green Valley Elementary, where she was known as 'Mrs. Z', for a total of 35 yrs. 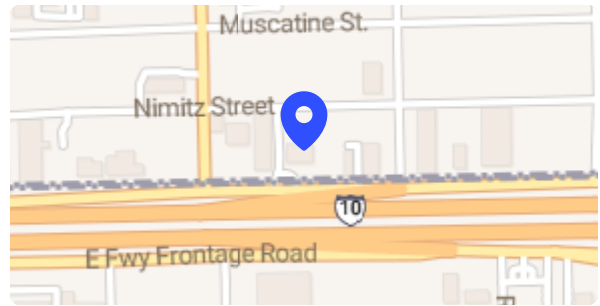
