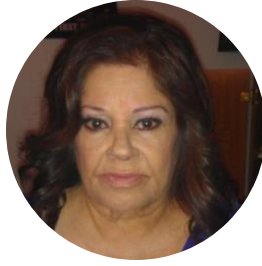

We would like to thank everyone for their love and support during this time.

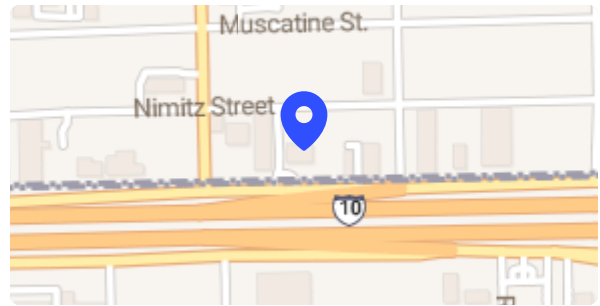
