At this time the Rollins family would like to thank everyone for their support during this difficult time, your thoughts and prayers are greatly appreciated.



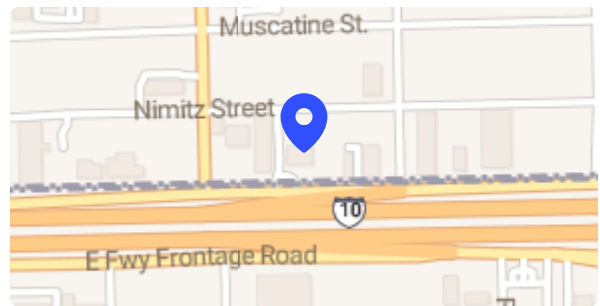
