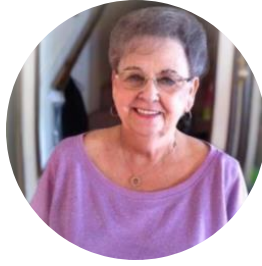

Donna Hewitt Gough, 86 years old, a resident of Houston, TX passed away peacefully on November 12, 2021. She entered this world on October 16, 1935, born to Joseph and Mabel Hewitt, in Sioux City, Iowa. Donna loved to entertain and cook for family and friends. She loved painting, crafts, and ceramics for which she won many medals.
