He is preceded in death by his parents Pedro Coronado, Benita Coronado, brother Gilbert Coronado, Sister Carmel Coronado.

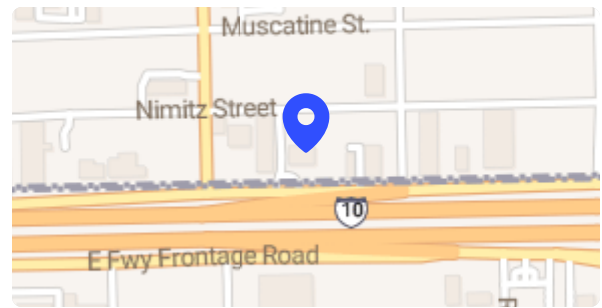

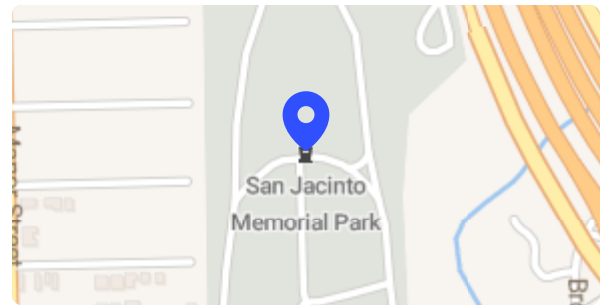

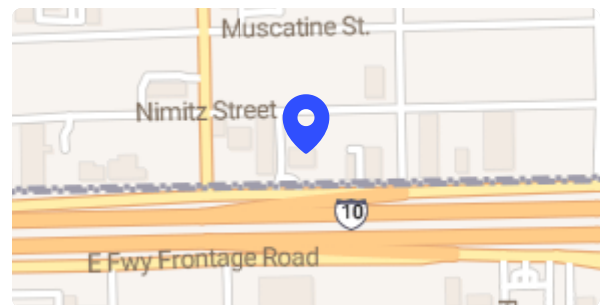
