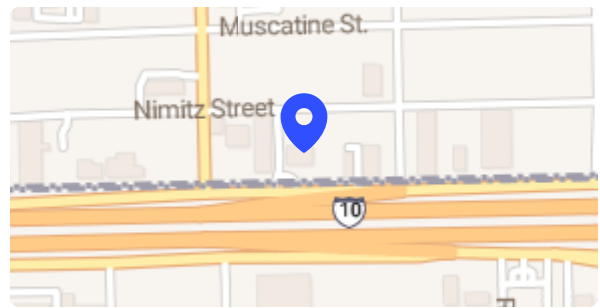

He is survived by his loving mother, Marisol, his father, Luis, his little brother, Gael, and his grandparents and his loving other relatives and friends.



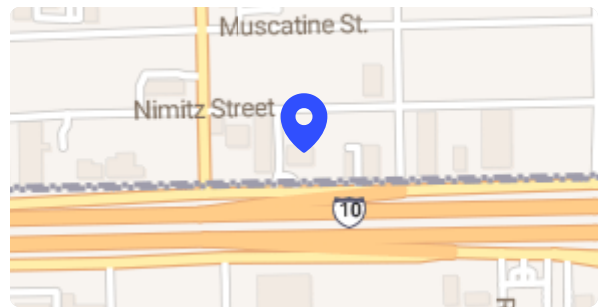
