Jose will be dearly missed by his loving family and friends. His legacy of hard work, faith, and love for his family will continue to inspire those who knew him

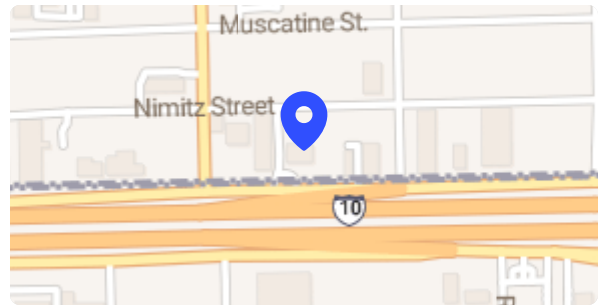
