Jimmie will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved her. Her legacy of love, faith, and dedication to family and community will live on in the hearts of those she touched.






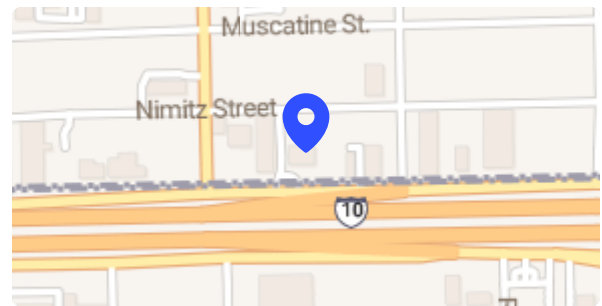
