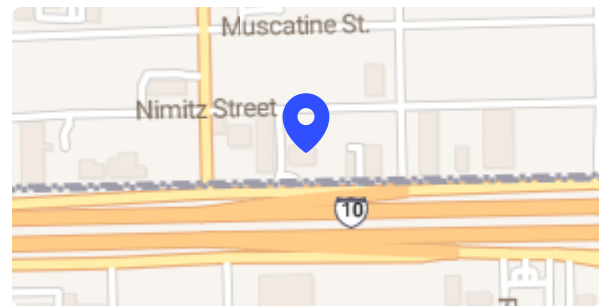

Eder will be dearly missed by his family and friends, who will forever remember his love, kindness, and the joy he brought into their lives.






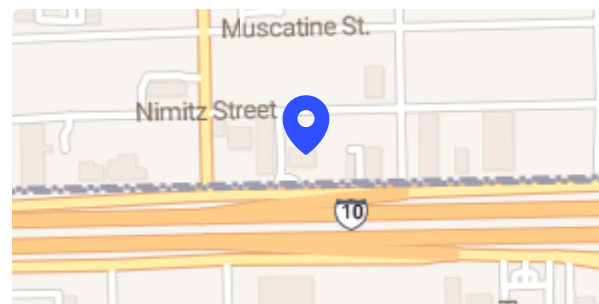

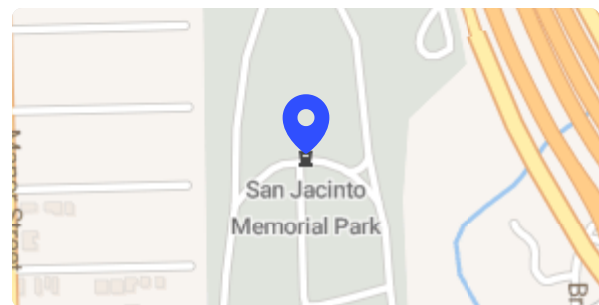

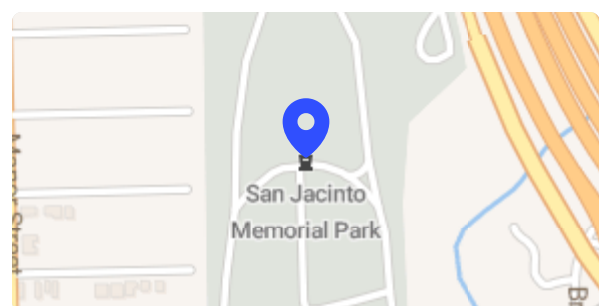
