Bettie's life was a tapestry of kindness, strength, and unwavering devotion. Her memory will be forever cherished by all who were blessed to know her.






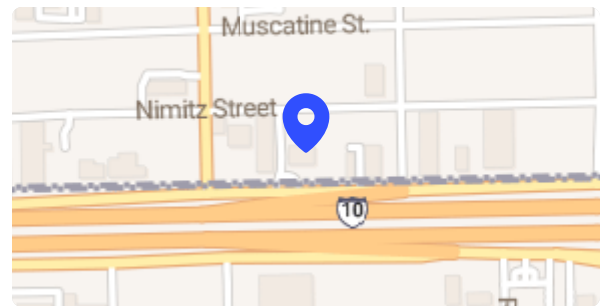
