In Loving Memory of James F. Farrington (1937–2025)

James F. Farrington, age 88, of Houston, Texas, passed away peacefully on July 3, 2025, in Baytown, Texas. Born on March 18, 1937, in Albany, New York, James was the cherished son of Robert Patrick Walsh and Mary Rose Walsh.

On December 27, 1958, James married the love of his life, Clara Wroblewski, in Galena Park, Texas. Their enduring partnership of over 66 years was a testament to love, faith, and family.

James proudly served in the National Guard from 1954 to 1963, attaining the rank of Sergeant. He carried that same sense of duty and integrity into his professional life. He worked as a lineman for Houston Light and Power for 24 years, then as a supervisor at Buffalo Paving for 8 years, and later served as maintenance director for Sheldon Independent School District for 12 years. His dedication and work ethic left a lasting impact on all who knew him.

A true outdoorsman, James found joy in fishing, hunting, and golfing. Whether casting a line or walking the fairway, he embraced the peace and camaraderie of nature.

James is survived by his devoted wife, Clara Farrington; his daughter Robin Zurovec and husband Troy Zurovec; his son David Farrington; his grandchildren Samson Farrington, Kaden Farrington, and Layla Farrington Luff and husband Cameron Luff; and his great-grandchild Katherine. He is also survived by his siblings: Eva Moore and husband Arvil, Margaret Farrington, June Bridgewater and husband Lee, and John Farrington and wife Gloria.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Mary Walsh; his sisters Susan Walsh and Mary Morris; and his brother Robert Walsh.
