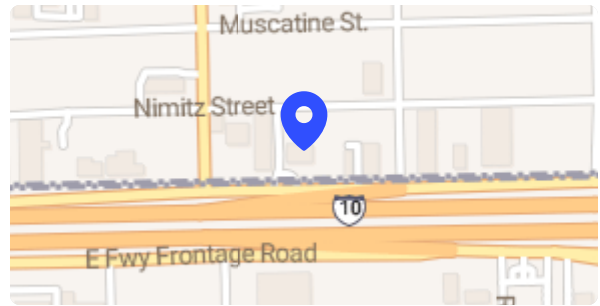
She is preceded in death by her beloved husband Juan M. Gaytan, her sister Argentina de Hoyos, and her brother Francisco Ramirez.

Maria will be dearly missed by all who knew her. Her legacy of love, laughter, and faith will continue to live on in the hearts of her family and friends.






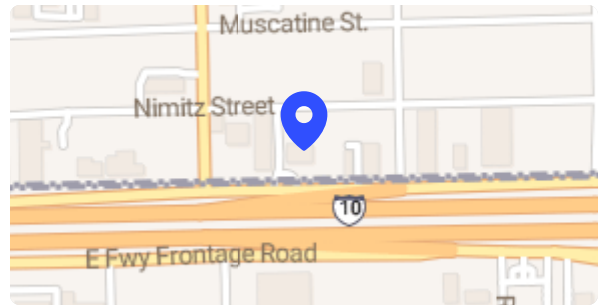
