Catherine “Cat” George passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, August 21, 2025, after a long battle with Alzheimer's/Dementia.

Born on September 2, 1940, in Talladega, Alabama, Catherine was raised by her devoted mother, Ann Ruth Warwick, along with the loving support of her aunts Mildred Swain (“Aunt Bo”), Rosie Mae Threat (“Aunt Put Tut”), and Bernice Richardson (“Aunt Bonnie”). She attended elementary school in Talladega before moving to Gary, Indiana, where she graduated from Roosevelt High School.

Catherine later attended San Jacinto College in Pasadena, Texas, where she discovered her passion for early childhood education. She went on to dedicate her career to teaching Pre-K and Kindergarten students as a Teacher’s Assistant. Her love for children touched countless young lives in Indiana, Texas, and South Carolina.

Catherine will be remembered as a joy to be around. She loved her family deeply, and her infectious laugh could brighten any room. Catherine's legacy is one of love, laughter, faith, and resilience. She will be deeply missed by all who knew her

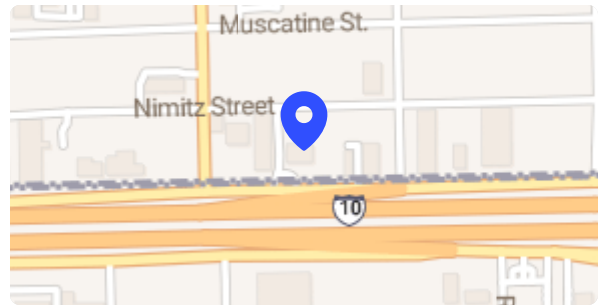

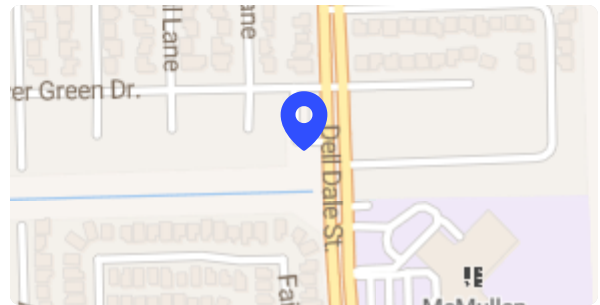
