Vicki will be remembered for her kindness, devotion to family, and the joy she brought to those around her. She will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved her.



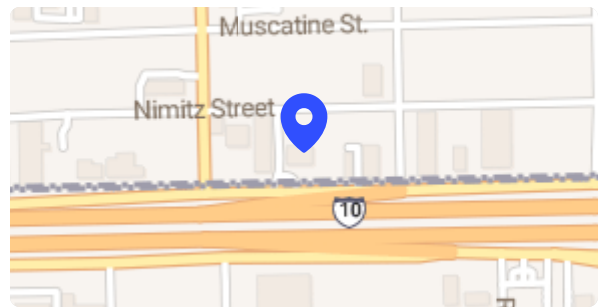
