May he rest in eternal peace.

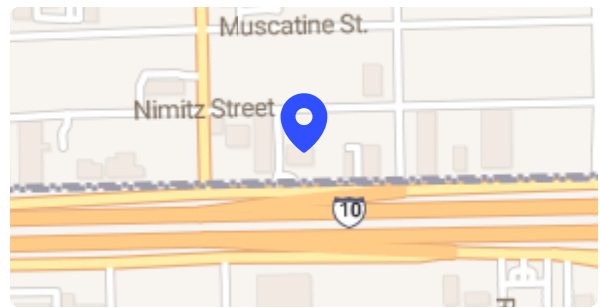
