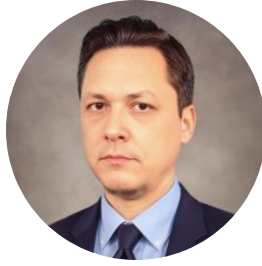

Vance's life was defined by loyalty, curiosity, and deep love for his family. His memory will continue to live on in the hearts of all who knew him.

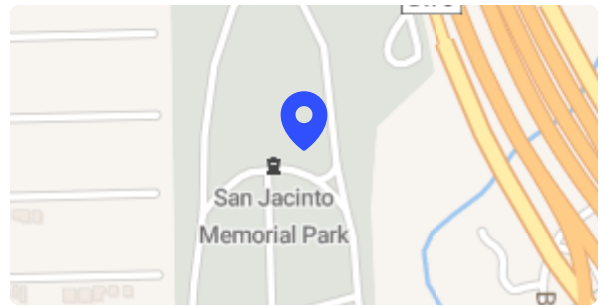

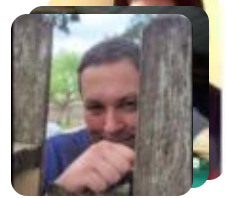

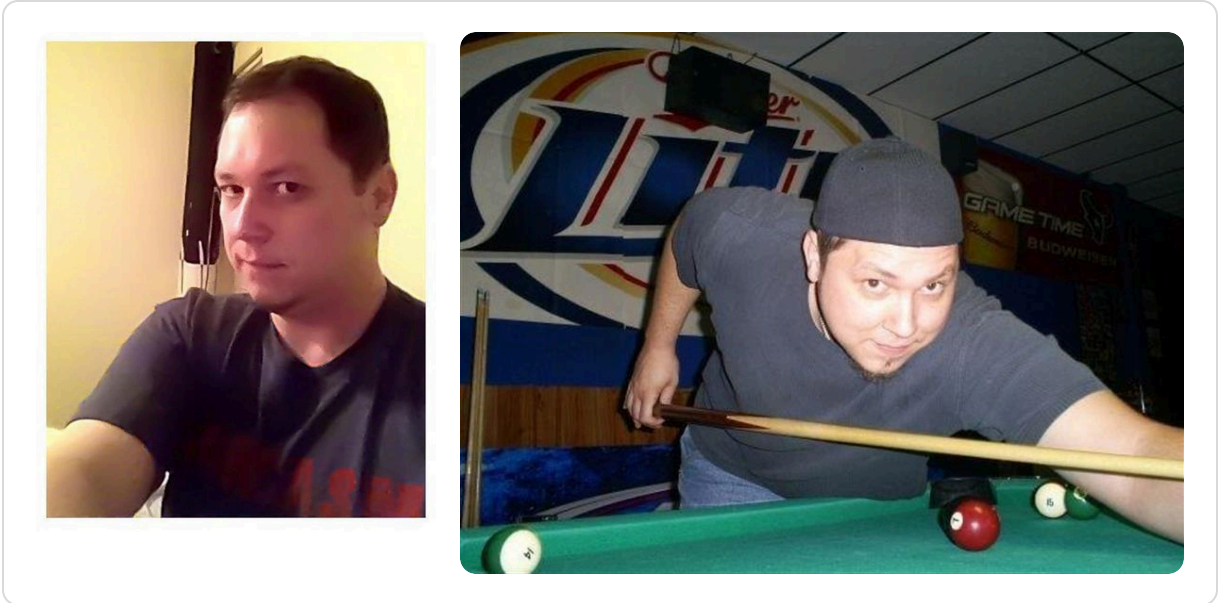
